

# Arbeitskreis Flüchtlinge Willkommen in **Kriftel**



The working team „Welcome in Kriftel“ (Arbeitskreis Flüchtlinge „Willkommen in Kriftel“) supports you in all questions of your everyday life in Kriftel and Germany. The working team are all volunteers helping other people without being paid for it. We would like to support you to find your way in our city and through our social and professional environment and help you understand a bit more about our culture and values.

Some examples:

- You want to learn German.
- You are sick or ill.
- Your children should go to school.
- You need clothes and household appliances.
- You want to play soccer.

**Consultation hours** are held at the City Hall (Rathaus) (see map). There are usually two of us - if necessary, a translator will be invited.

You will get your registration certificate there, that you need to open a bank account. The appointment for picking up the certificate will be posted.

**Apply for a bank account** once you have the registration certificate

The “Taunus Sparkasse” is located at Frankfurter Str. 8 and the “Volksbank” at Frankfurter Str. 3 (see map).

The working team provides **German lessons** at various locations. The dates, time and places for the lessons will be provided to you in advance.

---

The **clothing counter** is located at Goethestrasse 5. Here you will be initially equipped with free clothing. You get one voucher per person for free for your first visit in the clothing counter. Thereafter you can buy things for a small amount of money.

---

**Shops for food** are Lidl, Aldi or Rewe. The location of the shops are marked in the map.

---

The **coffee house of cultures** (Café der Kulturen) takes place every last Saturday of the month at 03:00-05:00 p.m.

Here you will meet with other refugees and volunteers getting to know each other.

**Location:** Recreational house (Freizeithaus) a flat building between the “Linden-“ and “Weingartenschule” (schools) at Staufenstrasse 14.
